Trust ye in the LORD forever, for in the LORD YHVH is everlasting strength. Isaiah 26:1-4 (KJV)

Being justified by faith, we have peace with GOD through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom also we have access by faith, into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the Glory of GOD. Romans 5:1-2 (KJV)

It came to pass, that as He [Yahshua/Jesus] was come nigh unto Jericho, a certain blind man sat by the way side begging, and hearing the multitude pass by, he asked what it meant. They told him, that Jesus of Nazareth passes by. He cried, saying, Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me! They which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace, but he cried so much the more, thou Son of David, have mercy on me!

Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto Him; and when he was come near, He asked him, saying, what wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? He said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. Jesus said unto him, receive thy sight; thy faith hath saved thee. Immediately he received his sight and followed Him, glorifying GOD; and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise unto GOD! Luke 18:35-43 (KJV)

Notice Yahshua's statement: "thy faith hath made thee whole". Within the Holy Scriptures, it is stated, "without faith it is impossible to please GOD".

Faith is complete trust; it is unshakeable conviction, that what has been requested or hoped for shall be provided, and all in the Mighty Name of Yahshua ha Mashiach, who is the Son of the One True and Living GOD!



We as believers **know beyond a shadow of a doubt** that our Father, which is in Heaven shall provide all that we need through His Holy Son!

When we humble ourselves and go to His Throne of Grace with thanksgiving, and present our requests to Him. **Read**: Romans chapter 1:17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:38, Genesis chapter 15:6; Romans 4:3; Galatians 3:6; James 2:23

What about pre-requisites?

Humble ourselves and pray, repent for all unrighteousness, abide in Yahshua, who is the Word of GOD. Read: John chapter 1; John chapter 15 offer sacrifices of thanksgiving, afterwards, let our requests be made known unto Him, and we do all this in the Name of His Holy Son, Yahshua ha Mashiach.

How to Overcome Anxieties

Be careful (anxious) for nothing, in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto GOD. The <u>peace</u> of GOD, which passes all understanding, <u>shall keep</u> your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 (KJV)

Jesus taught the people to take no thought for food or clothing, in other words, do not be anxious for these things (Matthew 6:25-33). According to Yahshua, we should seek the Kingdom of GOD, and all its righteousness (Matthew 6:23), and things that we need will be added unto us. It is written, within the Holy Scriptures: Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee, because he trusteth in thee. Isaiah 26:3 (KJV)

In order to have **perfect peace**, our minds must be continuously on the **ON THE ONE GOD** at all times via thanksgiving, worship, prayer, studying and reading the Holy Scriptures. If we believe in Yahshua we have the Holy Father. Yahshua stated: **I and my Father are one**. John 10:30 (KJV) **Read**: John chapters 10 & 15

Yahshua told His sorrowing disciples (regarding His departure from the earth) peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you, not as the world gives, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. John 14:27 (KJV)

Whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope. Romans 15:4 (KJV)

Note: This is a perfect time to acknowledge the One True and Living GOD, and to believe in His plan of salvation for mankind, namely His Holy Son, Yahshua ha Mashiach. Through belief in the birth, death and resurrection of His Son, we are saved from the wrath to come. Read: John chapter 1; John 3:16-21
